# Full Itinerary



## Day 1: Arrive in Jersey

Arrive in Jersey and experience the real character of its rich and colourful culture and enjoy a welcome meal at your 4\* hotel.



## Day 2: Explore Jersey

Take a walk around St Aubin's charming harbour and trek along spectacular cliffs and unspoilt sandy beaches. Enjoy a 'Taste of Jersey' tour sampling delicious food & wine stopping at local eateries. You will be introduced to local delicacies; some Jersey is famous for and some you might not have experienced. Spend the rest of the afternoon exploring Jersey at your leisure.



## Day 3: Jersey Heritage

Spend the morning enjoying Jersey's spectacular castles, historic houses and fascinating museums. In the afternoon, stroll through the Jersey Oyster trail - the biggest oyster beds in the British Isles and hear about the modern cultivation of shellfish in Jersey as well as the fascinating history of the oyster fishery, which in the 19th century was a major industry.



## Day 4: Arrive in Guernsey

Take the ferry to Guernsey and enjoy a guided walk through the streets of St Peters Port and try the local produce from home-made ice creams, freshly caught crab and indulgent Sark butter spread with jam. Pop into a local art house or visit Hauteville House, the home of one of the world's most celebrated authors - Victor Hugo, writer of 'Les Miserables.'



In the evening enjoy a walk around the town with chocolate tasting. Taking in the beautiful scenery, hear about the rich and interesting history of both the town and the island. Arrive at the premises of Ben Le Prevost, an award winning chocolatier and be greeted with a glass of Prosecco, juice or water. Here you will find out about the process from bean to beautifully crafted finished product, tasting as you go.



## Day 5: Discover Sark

Take the ferry to Sark and explore by horse and carriage. This tiny island nestled between France and England has no cars, time seems to slow down as you enter the land of stunning landscapes and tranquil coastline. Visit the La Seigneurie House and Gardens, a horticultural treasure and enjoy the flavours of Sark with a delicious lunch on its terrace café.



## Day 6: Explore Guernsey

Take the Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society Walk inspired by author Mary Ann Shaffer's trip to Guernsey in the 1970's. The book is a fictional tale depicting life in Guernsey both during and after the occupation of WWII. Hop on The Guernsey Explorer to explore the rest of the island at your own pace before enjoying a farewell dinner at Château La Chaire.
